I. INTRODUCTION

The I-70 East environmental impact statement (EIS) project team conducted a community leaders coordination meeting on March 20th, 2013 as part of the on-going community outreach process. The primary purpose of the meeting was to discuss the progress of the project, introduce the recommended preferred alternative, and invite community leaders to participate in the upcoming corridor-wide meetings.

The meeting started at 4:30 pm as an informal meeting with no presentation.
