

# Construction

Construction impacts cannot be accurately quantified until more detailed designs are generated. These designs would identify construction methods, phasing plans, and likely staging areas. During the development of the DEIS, it is only possible to speculate how resources might be impacted. Resources potentially impacted include:

- Transportation through temporary congestion and road closures, and possible sidewalk rerouting
- Right of way during property acquisition
- Visual quality through temporary view obstructions and construction staging
- Air quality through fugitive dust and construction machinery emissions
- Noise and vibration during the use of heavy machinery and site excavation
- Water quality through sedimentation
- Historic resources through excavation

## Construction Duration

Funding is not yet available for the construction of the project. Due to this limitation, the expected construction duration is not known at this time. If adequate funding for construction of the corridor were available at project outset, any of the alternatives could be constructed in a four- to five-year duration. However, if funding is only available in smaller amounts, the construction duration could become considerably longer.
