


# Economic Conditions

Economic resources include a variety of factors that may impact an area’s economy. Transportation projects must consider the following potential economic concerns:

- Employment and tax base impacted by project (retail sales, opportunity for development, tax revenues, relocation of employment centers, etc.)
- Businesses impacted by project or construction
- Jobs created during construction
