The Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) and Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) are conducting the I-70 East Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) to identify highway improvements along I-70 in the Denver urban area between I-25 and Tower Road near Denver International Airport that would improve safety, access, and mobility and address congestion.

Tonight’s corridor-wide meeting is being held to provide an update on the project including the results of the Preferred Alternative Collaborative Team (PACT) process and gain input on the alternatives that are presented.
